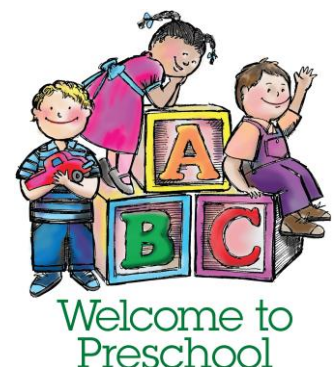
We are also fortunate to welcome SUNTEP student teachers into our school this month, working in Grades 2, 3, and both Grade 4 classrooms.
