Dear Parent/Caregiver:

Personal Electronic Devices, including items like cell phones, smart watches, tablets, personal gaming devices, and Bluetooth headphones, are not permitted during the school day by students in grades K-8, in accordance with provincial regulations. Personal Electronic Device use is not permitted during class or non-instructional time, unless permitted by a staff member. Students are expected to keep their devices at home, in their lockers, or with their teachers. Students cannot have devices on them during instructional hours.

If the guidelines for acceptable use are not followed, the student will turn their device in, and it will be returned at the end of the school day. If problems persist, the student may lose the privilege of having their device at school. It is important that our students understand appropriate use for personal devices. While we recognize these devices have become a common tool in society, the intent of such technology at school is strictly for learning purposes. For this reason, we have technology available for each student at the school that is used for learning when required for instructional activities.

Do I have to use a computer to use Edsby?

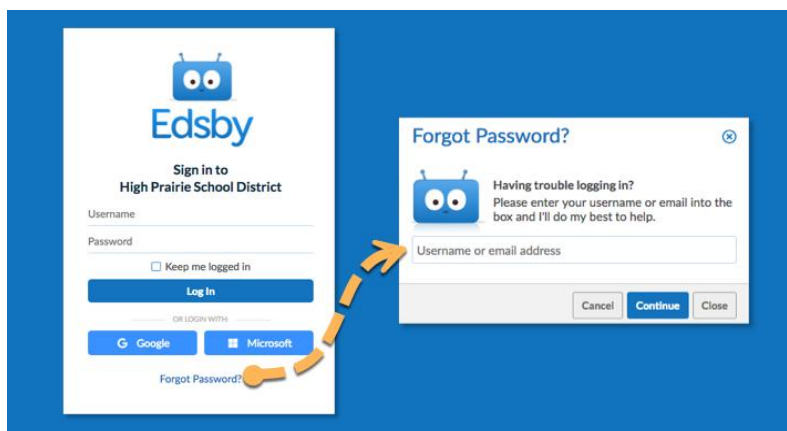

How to Add a Student

1. Sign in to School Cash Online through <https://srsd119.schoolcashonline.com/>.
2. Go to MY ACCOUNT.
3. From the dropdown menu, select My Students.
4. Click to add a student.
 - Type in your School Board Name.
 - Select School Name from the list.
 - Enter Student Criteria (Student Number, First Name, Last Name, Date of Birth).
 - CONFIRM

You may add up to **eight** students on your profile.

How to Make a Payment

1. You will be able to view any available items attached to your students that are set up on your account.
2. Select the item which you would like to purchase and click "Add to Cart."
3. Once you have finished adding items to your cart, select "Check Out" to make a payment.
